

## HEREFORD PEGASUS FOOTBALL CLUB ACTION PLAN FOR THE SAFE ADMISSION OF SPECTATORS

- 1. Admittance to Old School Lane is only permitted on the basis that the conditions in this notice are fully complied with. Any failure to observe these conditions will result in admittance being denied and/or individuals being asked to leave the site.
- 2. From 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2020 to 30<sup>th</sup> August 2020 the maximum number of spectators admitted to the ground is 150. Capacity will be increased to 300 spectators from 31<sup>st</sup> August 2020 until further direction is received from the Football Association and/or DCMS.
- 3. Individuals planning to attend should self-assess for Covid symptons (high temperature (above 37.8C), a new, continuous cough, loss or change to sense of smell or taste). If any of these symptoms are present do not travel or attempt to gain admittance to the ground and follow NHS guidelines for self-isolation and testing.
- 4. A contact name and telephone number will need to be provided to gain admittance to the ground. This information will be used solely to support the NHS Track & Trace service and will be held securely for 21 days from the date of the fixture and destroyed after this date.
- 5. Spectators and others in attendance should practice social distancing at all times avoiding close contact with persons outside of their 'social bubble'. Spectator groups must be restricted to discrete six-person groups in line with wider Government guidance.
- 6. A one way system will be in place at the ground with appropriate signage. This must be observed at all times.
- 7. Toilet facilities will be available but restricted to no more than one person at any time.
- 8. Hand sanitiser dispensers will be available to use around the ground and clubhouse, regular use is encouraged.
- 9. The clubhouse bar will be open for drinks and light snacks only (crisps, chocolate etc). Contactless payments should be used, where possible. Once served, spectators are requested to avoid lingering around the bar area and should either move to a table (ensuring social distancing guidelines are followed) or exit the clubhouse to consume their purchases outside.
- 10. Treat club volunteers and staff with respect and follow any instructions that are given to you. These measures are in place both to protect you and others whilst allowing the safe return of spectators to our matches.
